

## **Subject: Recyclability of our coated cardboard packaging**

We hereby confirm that our used corrugated cardboard packaging with non-stick coating is fed into the waste paper cycle and can therefore be used in the recycling process of waste paper for paper production.

We refer to the European list of standard grades of paper and board for recycling EN 643:2014, which sets grade-specific limits for undesirable materials in recovered paper. These include non-paper components, paper unsuitable for production, non-grade paper, cardboard and paperboard.

The limit values defined in EN 643, which apply to our packaging, are described under waste paper types 1.04 – corrugated board. The limit value for undesirable materials in conjunction with the paper is max. 3.0% of the packaging weight.

Within the total grammage of our corrugated board packaging, the coating medium used – at 3.9 g/m<sup>2</sup> – has a proportion of less than 1.0% and is thus within the range of the permissible limit values.
